ARCHITIZER ANNOUNCES 6th ANNUAL A+AWARDS WINNERS **Diverse award recipients show architectural vision around the world**

NEW YORK, NY, July 30, 2018 – Architizer, the world’s leading online resource for architecture and building-products, announces the winners of the **6th Annual Architizer A+Awards**.

The A+Awards honor the best architecture, spaces, and products from across the globe. This year’s winners include: **Zeitz MOCAA by Heatherwick Studios, in Cape Town, South Africa; CityLife Shopping District by Zaha Hadid Architects, in Milan, Italy; Lego House by BIG - Bjarke Ingels Group, in Billund, Denmark; Chicago’s Apple Flagship Store by Foster + Partners; and Confluence Park by Lake|Flato, in San Antonio, Texas**. This year, the A+Awards received over 5,000 entries from 100+ countries. A jury-selected winner and a popular choice winner were awarded in each of the 98 categories, with popular choice winners determined by more than 400,000 public votes cast from around the world.

With projects from the Netherlands, Mexico, the USA, China and Denmark, these Honorees demonstrate extraordinary contributions to the profession across the globe, highlighting projects that champion architecture’s potential to positively impact everyday life.
